PROJECT 150 REPORT

The recommendation on the table for vote is **no longer** "gift cards" but instead the Lodge is looking at buy backpacks and school supplies. The number of students needing Project 150 help in the fall is 300 (referred by school counselors, welfare, and truant officers) Because of the cost of these items, providing 250 should keep us within our budget (\$5,000). (EXACT BUDGET TO BE PRESENTED AT JUNE 1 MEETING) Along with our purchase comes an opportunity to get to know one another by having a work night to assemble the packs. We then store them in one of our 3 storage spaces at Shine and deliver 60 once a week starting in mid-August for their distribution.
